What if...?

If you need medical assistance this insurance will ensure you go straight to the top of the waiting list, be treated privately and much more importantly, fast!

3. Critical Illness

It is possible to ensure yourself against certain disabling illnesses, eg: cancer and heart problems. If you are unfortunate to be diagnosed with such an illness and cannot return to work, you may be able to insure for a lump sum on diagnosis. This should help you through treatment and hopefully recovery.
